

## ERASMUS PROJECT PROPOSALS

### “European Practical Training Week for VET Students and Staff” *7 day mobility*

---

#### 1. Who we are

The Cooperativa de Enseñanza Vega Media de Alguazas is a VET provider located in Alguazas, Region of Murcia (Spain), with Erasmus+ OID E10099230. We are a cooperative school offering:

- Basic VET in Administrative Services.
- Three intermediate VET programmes: Electrical Installations and Automation, Nursing Care, and Administrative Management.

Our educational project focuses on practical training, employability and internationalisation, in line with Erasmus+ priorities on inclusion and diversity, digital transformation, environmental sustainability and participation in democratic life.

#### 2. Our Erasmus+ experience

Our centre has more than 10 years of experience in Erasmus+ projects (KA1 and consortia), including student and staff mobility in several EU countries:

Additionally, our school is Erasmus accredited in Secondary Education (2021-2027) and has experience in individual mobilities.

#### 3. Main objective of the project

We aim to organise a 7-day group mobility (Key Action 1 – VET learners and staff mobility) for approximately:

- 10–15 VET students (intermediate level) from Electrical Installations and Automation, Nursing Care and Administrative Management.
- 4–6 VET teachers/trainers.

The main objective is to strengthen practical skills, European citizenship and employability of our learners and staff through short but intensive training periods in a European host organisation, fully aligned with Erasmus+ quality standards and recognition tools such as the Europass Mobility Document.

Indicative timing:

- The mobility would preferably take place at the end of May 2026 (exact dates

depending on the approval and calendar of the Erasmus+ call).

Financial considerations:

- We work with a limited budget and with students with modest socio-economic backgrounds, therefore we are especially interested in countries with a moderate cost of living, to ensure inclusion and equal participation.

#### **4. Type of activities planned**

During the 7-day mobility, we envisage activities such as:

- Work-based learning / traineeships for students in:
  - Electrical installations and basic automation (e.g. energy efficiency, basic smart installations).
  - Nursing care and social/health services (e.g. elderly care, basic patient support in non-clinical settings).
  - Administrative tasks (e.g. office work, customer service, basic accounting/administration).
- Job shadowing and professional exchanges for teachers in VET institutions or companies.
- Workshops and visits related to:
  - Digital tools in VET (use of ICT in administration, basic digitalisation in electrical installations, etc.).
  - Green and sustainable practices (energy saving, waste reduction, sustainable mobility, etc.).
  - Inclusion and diversity in VET (support for learners with fewer opportunities).

All activities will be transnational, structured and linked to clear learning outcomes, which will be assessed, recognised and documented according to Erasmus+ guidelines.

#### **5. Profile of partners sought**

We are looking for:

- VET providers (schools, colleges) or companies/host organisations active in one or more of the following areas:
  - Electrical installations and automation.
  - Nursing care / social and health services.
  - Administrative and office work.
- Organisations with experience in receiving Erasmus+ VET students and staff for short-term mobilities.
- Capacity to host small groups for 7 days (support in organising placements, mentoring, and local logistics; accommodation can be organised jointly or externally, depending on the local context).
- Commitment to Erasmus+ horizontal priorities: inclusion and diversity, digital transformation, environmental sustainability and participation in democratic life.
- Preferably holding an Erasmus+ OID and familiar with Erasmus Quality Standards for mobility.

We can offer, in return:

- Hosting your students and staff in our VET programmes in Murcia in future projects.
- Cooperation in future KA2 / cooperation partnerships and participation in regional and European networks.
- Joint dissemination of results and visibility at local and regional level, in line with Erasmus+ communication requirements.
